

Beyond the Spark: New Frontiers in RadioScience



GUIDELINES FOR PARTECIPATION

The participation to the Young Researcher 3MT Competition "My Research and Marconi's Legacy" is divided into three phases:

Phase 1: Application

- 1. Eligibility criteria:
 - Applicants must be younger than 35 years old and must be enrolled in a PhD program or be up to the 2nd year of PostDoc at the date of the Event.
 - Applicants' research focus must be within the areas of interest identified by the URSI commissions.
 - Applicants must agree to a declaration of intent to participate in person and at their own expenses, to the event *Beyond the Spark: New Frontiers in RadioScience* that will be held on <u>February 6th 2026</u> at the Sala Marconi, National Research Council (CNR) —Piazzale Aldo Moro 7, 00185 Rome. Any finalist who is unable to attend in person must <u>notify the organizer Micol Colella and the chair of the respective URSI commission</u> by <u>January 15th 2026</u>. In such case the finalist will be excluded from the competition and the next eligible participant in the ranking will be advanced.

2. Submission form:

- Applicants must send their applications via google form <u>Young Researchers</u>
 Session Application Form by <u>December 23rd 2025</u>.

Phase 2: Selection

- 1. After the review process, one finalist per commission will be selected. Finalists will be announced on **January 10th 2026.**
- 2. Upon selection, finalists will be required to confirm to the chair of the respective URSI commission by January 15th 2026 their acceptance and their commitment to attend in person, and at their own expenses (no travel support will be provided), the event Beyond the Spark: New Frontiers in RadioScience. In case of withdrawal by a finalist, the spot will be assigned to the next eligible participant in the ranking.

Phase 3: The competition

- The competition will be held in occasion of the event Beyond the Spark: New Frontiers in RadioScience (February 6th 2026, Sala Marconi, National Research Council (CNR) Piazzale Aldo Moro 7, 00185 Rome), during the Young Researchers Special Session.
- 2. Presentations must follow the rules of the 3MT competition (Competition rules Three Minute Thesis University of Queensland (uq.edu.au)). Examples of 3MT pitches can be found in this collection 3 Minute Thesis (3MT) Competition 2024- Examples.
